

# **Chhattisgarh Pradesh Chess Association**

## **FINANCIAL REGULATIONS** **WITH EFFECT FROM 26/12/2015**

### **A. The revenue of the Association will Include**

- 1) Membership/ Subscription to be paid by Affiliated Associations/institutional Members/Life Members/Patrons.
- 2) Entry fee to be paid by the Organizers of State Championships.
- 3) Non refundable EMD to be paid by the Organizers of State / national / International Tournaments.
- 4) Chhattisgarh and All India open rating tournaments CPCA will charge Recognition fee for Championships/Tournaments
- 5) Fee for conducting / organizing International Tournaments
- 6) Fee for the award of Certificates CPCA Level Trainers/ Arbiters/ Coaches
- 7) Players Registration fee
- 8) Fees received for services rendered or rights granted by CPCA
- 9) Other contributions like sponsorship etc.
- 10) CPCA Website advertisement charges
- 11) Such other receipts as may be incidental or mandatory to the above.

### **B. Affiliation Fee / Special Membership Fee**

Each affiliated Districts shall pay to the Association the annual subscription of Rs.2000/- (Rs. Two Thousand Only) between 1<sup>st</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> of April or with a fine of Rs.100/- before 30<sup>th</sup> April of that year. The annual subscription of Rs 10,000/- for the Institutional Members shall also be paid as above.

### **C. Entry Fee**

State Championship

W.E.F.16.10.2016 Entry Fee share for any state championship will not be charged by the state only EMD as prescribed in the schedule has to be paid by the organizing district to the state. The organizing district will pay the reimbursement towards the players selected to play nationals . The reimbursement of Rs4000/- per player will

be paid by the organizing district to the state before the start of round 3 of the tournament.

The same will be reimbursed to the player by the state after he plays the tournament and submits the necessary documents as scheduled. The dress code (2 T-shirts per player) will be given to the selected players free of cost by the organizing district. The T-shirts have to be purchased from the state by the organizing district. No cash prizes can be mentioned on the brochure of any state selection tournament, if any sponsor wishes to give cash prizes then the organizers would seek prior permission from the state and will announce before giving the cash prizes that it is the sponsor who is giving away the prizes and not CPCA or the organizing district.

If the payment is not made within the stipulated period, the organizers will be liable to pay 2% interest per month on the defaulted sum. W.E.F 16.10.2016

### **C1 – Selected players from Districts and Divisions-**

Every district Association and Division is allowed following number of entries as official entries for state selection tournaments. Entries will be accepted on letter head only.

For age-group U-15, U-19 and Open and women event 4 entries per district /division. For all other state selection tournaments 2 entries from each category per district / division.

### **C2 – Seeded Players –**

Top 4 players from every state selection tournament will be seeded for the same group and 1 higher group for e.g. top 4 players from U-7 for 2012 will be seeded for 2013 U-7 and 2013 U-9 state tournament.

### **C3 – Accommodation**

### **C4 – Tournament Director –**

Every organizer will appoint tournament director for the official event like, State selection tournament, Rating tournament, and any other official event which will need permission from CPCA, AICF or FIDE.

TD will be responsible for overall conduct of the tournament, to follow all the rules and regulations set by CPCA, AICF, FIDE, to follow protocol, and send daily press reports. In case of Dispute his decision in consultation with secretary CPCA will be final and binding on all.

### **C5 – Tie Break –**

For all the state selection tournaments tie – break system will be as per the new and current FIDE laws

**C6 -** The Organizers of all official championships like National, Asian, World, Commonwealth, Asian Zone etc., shall pay Rs. 5,000/- to CPCA for non granted event, and Rs. 10,000/- for granted event.

The entry fee once paid shall not be refundable.

#### **D. International Events**

Chhattisgarh players aspiring to participate in International events as Donor/Special Entries shall submit their entries through CPCA to the AICF in the prescribed form.

#### **E. Non Refundable Earnest Money Deposit for National / International Competitions:**

Organizers of National Tournaments shall pay to the CPCA non-refundable Earnest Money Deposit at the rates given below along with the bid form in advance. The application along with the Non Refundable Earnest Money Deposit shall be sent four months in advance with a detailed proposal and estimated budget to the AICF Secretariat.

FIDE Rating (Swiss) : Entry Fee should not exceed 0.5% of the Prize Money if the tournament is conducted within 5 days. Entry Fee should not exceed 1% of the total prize money if the tournament is conducted more than 5 days. CPCA Recognition Fee - 5% of the total prize fund subject to a minimum of Rs.5,000/-

Open State Tournaments : Any State level Open Tournament – EMD is 5% or minimum Rs.5,000/-

Open Rating Tournaments with rating restrictions : Entry Fee should not exceed 0.5% of the Prize Money if the tournament is conducted within 5 days. Entry Fee should not exceed 1% of the total prize money if the tournament is conducted more than 5 days. CPCA Recognition Fee - 5% of the total prize fund subject to a minimum of Rs.5,000/-

**Entry Fee for State Championship and National Championship are exempt from this 1% Rule.**

**F. Fee for the award of Titles and Certificates.**

Following fees shall be payable to the CPCA for the award of Titles and Certificates subject to changes introduced by CPCA from time to time.

**G. Players Registration Fees:**

Players Registration fees per year : Rs.200/-

**H. Academy Registration fees per year:** Rs.1000/-

**I. Arbiter Registration Fee** : Rs.500/-

**J. Coaches registration fees** : Rs. 500/-

**K. Selected/ Seeded players representing Chhattisgarh at National Championships.**

**K1** - Selected and seeded Players will be paid 3,000/- lump sum amount towards travel, Boarding and entry fees for representing Chhattisgarh state at Nationals championships.

**K2** - For all rapid and blitz National Participation players will be played 1,500/- Rs. The amount will be reimbursed to the players after production of Participation certificate.

**L. Cash Incentives for Medal winners in Official Championships**

The CPCA shall present the players with the following cash incentives whenever they win Medals in the Official Chess Championships as detailed below.

**M. Organizers of State Championships shall pay the following to the Chief Arbiter nominated by the Association.W.E.F 16.10.2016**

1. All Classical State Championships Rs.3,500.00
2. All State Rapid Championships Rs.2,000.00
3. State Blitz Championships Rs. 1,500.00
4. Per day charges for all rating events Rs. 500.00
5. Apart from the above, the Chief Arbiter shall be reimbursed to & fro 3<sup>rd</sup> AC train fare, free Board & lodge apart from local transportation. If arbiter is local he will be eligible for free boarding only.

**N. Organizers of National Championships shall pay the following to the Deputy Arbiters nominated by the Association.W.E.F 16.10.2016**

1. All Classical State Championships Rs.3,000.00
2. All State Rapid Championships Rs.2,000.00
3. State Blitz Championships Rs. 500.00
4. Per day charges for all rating events Rs. 500.00
5. Apart from the above, the Chief Arbiter shall be reimbursed to & fro 3<sup>rd</sup> AC train fare, free Board & lodge apart from local transportation. If arbiter is local he will be eligible for free boarding only.

**O . Regulations for arbiters –**

**01** - Number of arbiters per tournament - For first 50 players 2 arbiters, for additional every 50 players 1 arbiter.

**02** - Chief and deputy Arbiters will be responsible for smooth conduct of the tournament according to FIDE, AICF, CPCA rules and regulations.

**03** -Arbiters will complete all the formalities regarding AICF, CPCA player registrations, Rating results for AICF and FIDE, and will submit the report of the event with total number of players and final standings to CPCA within 15 days after completion of the tournament.

**P. Authorized tournaments**

1. Organizers for the event should apply for the permission of the tournament in advance to CPCA thru the respective district and Divisional Association.
  - A. Rating tournaments – 60 days in advance
  - b. State Selection Tournaments – 60 days in advance
  - c. State Open tournaments (unrated) – 30 days in advance
  - d. State open blitz and rapid (Unrated) – 30 days in advance

#### **P1 -Unauthorized Tournaments –**

1. District and divisional association should inform the CPCA for requesting CPCA to declare the tournament unauthorized.
2. CPCA will announce the tournament as unauthorized on its website.
3. Players, Arbiters registered with CPCA are not authorized to participate in any unauthorized tournaments.

#### **P2 – Players / Arbiters participating in unauthorized tournaments**

1. Players / arbiters participating in unauthorized tournaments will face the disciplinary action by CPCA.
2. Players participating in unauthorized tournaments will not be allowed to participate in the any CPCA events or to represent CPCA in any events till the EC meeting takes place.
3. Disciplinary Action taken by Executive committee will be final and binding on all.
4. President of CPCA can pardon any player/ arbiter.

#### **Q. Payment to the Office Bearers and Secretariat Staff**

1. Traveling expenses of the Hon. Secretary  
The Secretary shall be paid airfare for his actual journeys performed in connection with the championship / Tournament of the Association, Meetings of the Association and any secretarial job requiring his personal attendance. In addition he shall be eligible incidental allowance of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) for each day of travel and halt. He shall also be eligible for being re-imbursed with the actual hotel expenses on production of proper bills, Expenses for traveling by other modes of conveyance shall also be met by the Association. The same facility will be extended to the other Office Bearers with the approval of the EC pre or post facto.

#### **R. Conditions of Services of the Secretariat Staff**

1. The number and the category of the secretarial staff to be engaged and the remuneration and other benefits which they will enjoy will be decided by the President.

2. All Sundays and Central Government public holidays shall be holidays for the CPCA Secretariat provided however that no member of staff shall decline to work on such holidays in the event of an exigency.
4. The Secretarial Staff shall also be eligible for twelve days of non cumulative casual leave in a Calendar year subject to the condition that not more than three days of the leave shall be availed of at a stretch other wise than on medical ground and also that leave shall not be claimed as a matter of right.
5. Medical reimbursement for self and dependents of staff will be subject to President's discretion.

### **CPCA CIS recognized Academies –**

\_To improve their chess knowledge further, and to facilitate their training, CPCA CIS is coming out with CPCA CIS recognized academies.

- These academies can be existing academies or
- Schools currently under CPCA CIS program which are ready to start chess as after school activity and open it to general public below the age of 20.

### **Guidelines for CPCA CIS Recognized Academies.**

1. Academies need to fill the form and send it to CPCA CIS with fees of Rs. 1,000/- PA (special Concessional Rate for 1<sup>st</sup> year)(year will be from Jan- December)
2. Academies are expected to register 25 players as CPCA registered players in a year.
3. Academies will submit the annual report to CPCA CIS, with major achievements of its students at School, District, State, National, International Level performances.
4. Academies will help CPCA CIS in running the CIS program in schools.

### **What CPCA CIS will offer –**

1. Academies can use the logo of CPCA CIS with the academy.
2. Name of academy will appear on CPCA CIS website as CPCA CIS recognised Academy.
3. CPCA CIS will share its experience in CIS program with the academies.
4. Academies will receive the circulars of all the CPCA registered tournaments in e-format.

### **Rules and regulations -**

1. CPCA CIS will have right to accept/ reject any application
2. In case of dispute between academies and CPCA CIS, any one can request CPCA Managing Committee for arbitration.
